Lunch Orders

There are limited options for purchasing lunch in Somers.

Alternatively, you are welcome to bring your own lunch. We have an outdoor kitchen on the upstairs deck with a sink, microwave, and small fridge, which you're welcome to use. Balnarring is a 10 minute drive away and has more options for purchasing food.
