## NOTICE OF RACE

The notation '[NP]' in a rule means that a boat may not protest another boat for breaking that rule. This changes RRS 60.1.

### 1. RULES

1.1. The event is governed by the rules as defined in The Racing Rules of Sailing(RRS).

1.2. RRS Appendix G3 is changed as follows. All changes shall be stated in the Sailing Instructions. The Sailing Instructions may also change other rules.

#### G3 CHARTERED OR LOANED BOATS

When so stated in the notice of race or sailing instructions, a boat chartered or loaned for an event may carry national letters or a sail number in contravention of her class rules, or a sail number that is not identical with other competitors.

1.3. If there is a conflict between the Sailing Instructions and the NoR, the Sailing Instructions shall take precedence. This changes RRS 63.5(c).

1.4. If there is a conflict between languages the English text takes precedence.

### 2. SAILING INSTRUCTIONS

Sailing Instructions will be available during registration at the event website. Other documents governing the event will be published with the Sailing Instructions.

### 3. COMMUNICATION

3.1. Registration shall be done online. An online platform for uploading all necessary documents and confirming entries will be available on the [event website](#).

3.2. The Official Notice Board will be online only, available on the event website.

3.3. Communication with competitors

The event will also use "WhatsApp." Details will be shown in the Sailing Instructions.

3.4. [DP] Except in an emergency or when using devices that supplied by the race committee, a boat shall not make data transmissions and shall not receive data communication that is not available to all boats. This restriction shall also apply to cell phone.

### 4. ELIGIBILITY AND ENTRY

4.1. Competitors shall be registered member of a member national authority of World Sailing.

4.2. Eligible boats may apply to participate by completing the online entry form on the Japan

Tasar Association website <http://tasarjapan.org/> and paying the required entry fee.

4.3. Boats completing their entry by February 28, 2026 (23:59 Japan Time, GMT+9) shall apply the Early Entry Fee. Boats completing their entry by April 30, 2026 (23:59 Japan Time, GMT+9) shall apply the Standard Entry Fee. Boats completing their entry on or after May 1, 2026 shall apply the Late Entry Fee (ref. NOR 5.1.).

4.4. Entries will be accepted until May 15. After that date, entries will be accepted at the discretion of the Organizing Authority.

## 5. ENTRY FEES

5.1. Entry fees are as follows:

5.1.1. Payment of entry fees shall be made by credit card.

5.1.2. The entry fee is in Japanese yen and includes consumption tax.

5.1.3. Entry fees will not be refunded.

## 6. [DP] [NP] ADVERTISING AND IDENTIFICATION

6.1. Boats shall display advertising chosen and supplied by the organizing authority.

## 7. RACE FORMAT

7.1. The event is scheduled for a maximum of 14 races, with a minimum of 3 races required to be scored to constitute the event.

## 8. SCHEDULE

8.2. The number of races per day may be changed depending on race conditions and other factors.

8.3. Depending on race conditions, races may be held on reserve day.

8.4. On-site registration for measurements will begin on June 4. This will be a reservation-based system with designated time slots.

8.5. On the last scheduled day of racing no warning signal will be made after 14:30.

## 9. [NP] [DP]EQUIPMENT INSPECTION

9.1. A Technical Committee shall be appointed in accordance with RRS 92.

9.2. Guidelines for competition measurement will be posted on the official notice board at least one week prior to these measurements.

## 10. CLOTHING AND EQUIPMENT

[DP] A competitor's clothing and equipment shall not weigh more than 9 kilograms, as permitted by RRS 50.1(b).

## 11. VENUE

NoR Addendum B shows the location of the racing areas.

## 12. COURSES

The course to be sailed will be set up in the shape of a triangle course with an approximate inner angle of 60 degrees. The course and other details will be shown in the sailing instructions.

## 13. PENALTY SYSTEM

RRS Appendix P, Special Procedures for Rule 42, will apply.

## 14. SCORING

14.1. RRS Appendix A will apply.

14.2. (a) When fewer than 5 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores.

(b) When from 5 to 8 races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her worst score.

(c) When 9 or more races have been completed, a boat's series score will be the total of her race scores excluding her two worst scores.

## 15. [NP] [DP]BERTHING

Boats shall be kept in their assigned places by the OA.

## 16. [DP] [NP] MEDIA RIGHTS, CAMERAS AND ELECTRONIC EQUIPMENT (DATA PROTECTION)

- 16.1. By participating in the event, competitors grant the Organizing Authority without compensation, the right to use at its sole discretion any videos, still photographs and any footage or prints taken of the competitor or the competitor's equipment during the event.
- 16.2. Boats may be required to carry cameras, sound equipment and positioning equipment as specified and supplied by the Organizing Authority.

## 17. INSURANCE

Each participating boat shall maintain valid third-party liability insurance providing coverage of at least ¥100 million (or equivalent) per incident. All owners/competitors who enter shall be deemed to have declared that they hold such insurance. Competitors shall be prepared to present proof of insurance upon request.

## 18. RISK STATEMENT

RRS 3 states: 'The responsibility for a boat's decision to participate in a race or to continue to race is hers alone.' By participating in this event each competitor agrees and acknowledges that sailing is a potentially dangerous activity with inherent risks. These risks include strong winds and rough seas, sudden changes in weather, failure of equipment, boat handling errors, poor seamanship by other boats, loss of balance on an unstable platform and fatigue resulting in increased risk of injury. Inherent in the sport of sailing is the risk of permanent, catastrophic injury or death by drowning, trauma, hypothermia or other causes.

## 19. PRIZES

Awards will be given as follows.

- Top 6 places overall 総合上位 6 位
- Masters Champion (combined age 80-99years)
- Grand Masters Champion (combined age 100-119years)
- Super Grand Masters Champion (combined age 120 years or more)
- First Female Helm
- First Youth Helm (helm is 19 years or younger)
